



STS, REGINA CHAPTER HISTORY BY DECADE

THE 1990s

Regina Chapter hosted Provincial bridge and golf (held in Foam Lake). Members who were in their 90's were honoured in 1995.

Regina Chapter's 25th Anniversary was marked during 1996-97.

In the fall of 1996, Provincial STS introduced medical and dental plans which members could purchase with no medical exam needed. Changes to the plans are suggested through resolutions presented to the Annual General Meeting (AGM) and then negotiated with the supplier.

A constitutional change in November, 1997, allowed the Regina Chapter to present an Award of Merit, honouring members who have made a substantial contribution to the Chapter.

Regina Chapter member, Terry McKague, served as Provincial president from 1999 to 2000.

There were various speakers and topics at the assembly meetings, but an unusual presentation was a fashion show, with some members modeling fashions of the last few decades.

Tours this decade were to Abernethy Museum, Motherwell Homestead, Bluenose Vacation Farm, Big Muddy, Moose Jaw Spa, Soo Line Museum, Cannington Manor, Great Sand Hills and Cypress Hills, Government House, Yorkton, Veregin and Rama.
